GENERAL ORDER

Dorsey, Chief Special Master:

On December 26, 2018, a General Order issued staying most deadlines for Respondent during the lapse in Department of Justice ("DOJ") appropriations that began on December 22, 2018. General Order issued December 26, 2018. Appropriations for DOJ have been restored and the December 26, 2018 General Order is revoked.

All deadlines for Respondent which fell between December 22, 2018 and January 28, 2019 are hereby extended 35 days from the date of the instant General Order absent a subsequent Order of the assigned special master. All deadlines for Respondent falling between January 28, 2019 and February 1, 2019 are hereby extended 30 days from the date of the instant General Order absent a subsequent Order of the assigned special master. Respondent shall prioritize the filing of Proffers, and Status Reports and/or Stipulations pursuant to 15-Week Orders.

This General Order does not apply to deadlines applicable to petitioners. Further, this General Order does not apply to deadlines to file a motion for review, motion for reconsideration, motion for redaction, or notice of appeal (petition for review).

This General Order shall be circulated within the court, transmitted to representatives of the Vaccine Injured Petitioners ("VIP") Bar Association and the DOJ, and posted on the court's website.
